Our Mission

We are a coalition of concerned residents, community groups and environmental justice organizations working to protect Michiganders health by working for everyone's right to a clean, safe, healthy environment.

Our goal is to build a stronger movement to protect clean air, promote environmental justice, build collaboration on air quality issues, and advance policies that protect clean air and public health in Southeast Michigan and across the state.

We are calling on lawmakers to protect communities from air pollution.

Clear the Air is asking Michigan lawmakers to enact cumulative impact laws and local ordinances that protect communities from air pollution. We've been working with city council members to push for local ordinances that prevent exposure to fugitive dust and diesel fumes. At the state level, we're advocating for cumulative impact laws, through which permitting agencies would consider existing pollution burden in a neighborhood and other characteristics, like the local asthma rates, before allowing new pollution sources into a community.
